Specialty Rooms and Additions

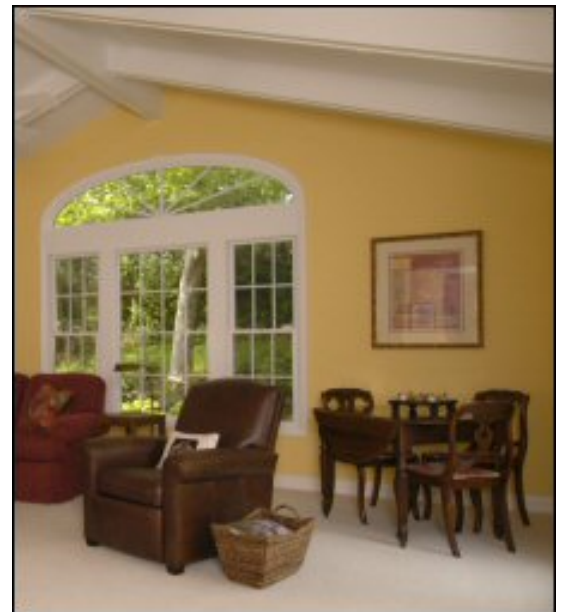
